



The Lakewood Education Foundation: In Memory of Ila Mason Scholarship

This scholarship is offered in memory of Ila Mason. Mrs. Mason was a member of the Lakewood community most of her life, graduating from Hebron High School in 1950, serving as the Secretary at Lakewood High School for 32 years and raising her 7 children in the Lakewood School System. She was an active member of the community including a 25 year member and past president of the Phi Beta Psi Sorority, Eagon Chapter #123, OES, Founding Board Member of the Buckeye Lake Historical Museum, Hebron Veterans Memorial Committee, Lakewood Retirees Breakfast and Lakewood Hall of Fame Inductee. She was also a member of the Hebron Christian Church for more than 50 years where she filled many leadership roles.

Contributing to the community in a positive way through school, church and other groups was important to Mrs. Mason. Students awarded this scholarship will be those who have had a positive impact on their school, church or community through groups, leadership roles or volunteer activities in which they are involved.

Eligibility: Students who wish to be considered for the Lakewood Education Foundation: In Memory of Ila Mason Scholarship must also meet the eligibility requirements below:

- Be a Lakewood High School graduate or senior planning to graduate in 2020
- Possess a 2.0 or higher cumulative grade point average (GPA)
- Plan to be a full-time student attending an accredited post-secondary school which accepts federal student aid.
- File a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
- Apply for campus-based and other sources of financial aid for which he/she may be eligible

(Children or grandchildren of LEF board members are not eligible to apply)

Include the following:

- Copy of one (1) Letter of Recommendation from a Community Member
- Copy of the Financial Aid Award Letter from college student plans to attend
- Unofficial copy of the high school transcript

Awards: The student must demonstrate unmet financial need in excess of \$100 as determined by the Financial Aid Award Letter, and any financial aid received from other sources. The awarded amount will not exceed \$500 based on need.

Expectation of Scholarship Awardees: A student awardee agrees to notify the Lakewood Education Foundation immediately if he/she does not attend, leaves, or

transfers from the designated college/school. He/she has 12 months from the award date to claim the scholarship funds and is also responsible for requesting any unused funds be returned to the Lakewood Education Foundation.
